TISS is part of a large consortium of 12 European universities and 8 Indian universities under the Erasmus Mundus External Co-operation Window Lot 15 (EMECW15). This consortium is led by the Lund University in Sweden and we have received a large grant for fellowships / scholarships of students and teachers at all levels.

The Erasmus Mundus External Co-operation Window Lot 15 (EMECW15) is a scholarship programme for students, researchers and academic staff from India and from EU, financed by the European Commission. It is an academic mobility scheme and partnership for education, research and development organized by the consortium.

The fellowship covers all the expenses. Candidates are required to fill in the on-line application at

We have identified a few courses which may be of interest to students and faculty from TISS but they can get further information from the respective web addresses given with each university. Kindly note that potential Indian applicants have been divided into three Target Groups. **It is the responsibility of the applicant to check to which Target Group he/she belongs and provide the necessary information as part of the application.**

1. **Target Group 1:** All the current students and faculty of TISS.
2. **Target Group 2:** Any Indian citizen fulfilling the eligibility criteria for the course applied for.
3. **Target Group 3:** Nationals of India who either have refugee status or are asylum beneficiaries (international or according to the national legislation of one of the

European recipient countries) or have been subjected to discrimination or unjustified exclusion from university on racial, ethnic, political, gender or sexual inclination grounds. Persons applying under this target group also should be registered in Indian higher education institutions not included in the partnership or have obtained university degrees or the equivalent from Indian higher education institutions.
